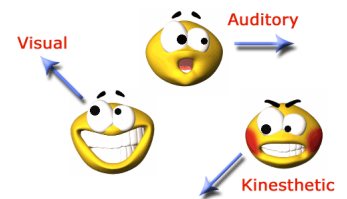
3. NLP Skills Practice
